Our members – stone, sand and gravel producers and the equipment manufacturers and service providers who support them – are responsible for the essential raw materials found in every home, building, road, bridge and public works project, and represent more than 90 percent of the crushed stone and 70 percent of the sand and gravel produced annually in the United States. Production of aggregates in the U.S. in 2018 was more than 2.36 billion metric tons at a value of \$25.3 billion. The aggregates industry employs approximately 107,000 highly-skilled men and women, and every \$1 million of stone, sand and gravel sales supports 4.2 jobs.



Government & Regulatory Affairs Committee

The Government & Regulatory Affairs Committee provides leadership in the development and implementation of NSSGA's government relations program; identifies, monitors and evaluates key federal and state legislative issues impacting members in the areas of transportation infrastructure, tax, labor, safety, health and the environment. In addition, it provides support in conjunction with the association's political action committee (ROCKPAC) for candidates who advocate positions consistent with NSSGA's established policy.

Legal Committee

Provides legal analysis and recommends legal positions or actions regarding the implications of policies and procedures developed by the Environmental Committee, Safety and Health Committee, Government Affairs Committee or on industry-specific litigation.

Meetings & Education

Identifies, develops, implements and evaluates educational programs, keynote speakers, training opportunities, and resources that focus on issues faced by the aggregates industry in order to inform and educate members. These activities include, the AGG1 Academy education program, distance learning programs, Basic and Advanced Sales Courses, Basic and Advanced Supervisory Courses, webinars, magazine articles, white papers, and videos.

ROCKPAC

Advances a pro-aggregates agenda with federal candidates. NSSGA's ROCKPAC is the only political action committee solely dedicated to aggregates industry, supporting candidates on a bipartisan basis with the ultimate goal being to help elect a pro-business, pro-transportation, pro-aggregates Congress.

The M&S Division Board

M&S Members are urged to work directly with producers on NSSGA's committees and subcommittees are invited to participate in workshops, seminars and conferences which gives member firms added exposure to present and potential customers.

Safety & Health Subcommittee

NSSGA's Safety & Health Subcommittee promotes excellence in safety and health affairs by developing and implementing programs to meet the unique needs of the aggregates industry consistent with the association's Safety & Health Guiding Principles; analyzes and comments on new and proposed regulations and legislation pertaining to occupational health and mine safety and disseminates information on regulatory compliance and administration of health and safety programs, including training.

The Environmental Subcommittee provides leadership in implementing the association's Environmental Guiding Principles; tracks environmental regulatory affairs; reviews, analyzes and comments on new and proposed environmental regulations and legislation; communicates changes in environmental laws, rules and policies to the membership; provides training to help member companies meet their environmental responsibilities; serves as a resource for member companies; communicates and works with other committees in the division, the association and state aggregates associations.
