

# GET OUT THE VOTE

## in New York

Voting is one of the most powerful ways to make your voice heard in our democracy, but in 2024, only 64% of the voting-age population in the United States reported voting.

Modern technology has improved access to information on candidates and made it easier to register to vote in many areas, and it is vital to be aware of how you can participate in the 2026 election cycle.

### PRIMARY ELECTION TYPE:

#### Closed

Voters must be a registered party member to vote in a closed primary. Independent or unaffiliated voters are excluded from participating in the party nomination contests.



### ABSENTEE AND MAIL-IN VOTING PROCEDURES

#### Permanent absentee/ mail-in voting procedures:

- Excuse required to request an absentee ballot
- Applications can be submitted by mail, in-person, email, fax, or online

### DEADLINES TO KNOW FOR VOTING IN

#### New York



#### VOTER REGISTRATION DEADLINE:

**June 13**

10 days before the election

#### ABSENTEE / MAIL-IN VOTING BALLOT DEADLINES:

Request must be received by

**June 13**

10 days before the election for mail and online requests; 1 day before the election for in-person requests.

#### BALLOT SUBMISSION DEADLINE:

**Postmarked by Election Day**

Must be received within seven days of the election if postmarked by Election Day.
